Dear Mr. Wells,

Mr. Scott is unfortunately away today with a cold, and in his absence I have opened your letter of the 24th instant relative to the classification of the vessels of your Company. I note the decision arrived at by the Board at their last meeting, and trust that the replies which you receive in the matter from your Agents in China will show the desirability of having the advantage of the inspection of your vessels from time to time by an independent authority, such as Lloyd's Register, having salaried Surveyors in the Far East.

I do not think there will be any difficulty in leaving undisturbed in the Register Book the class of the "YUSANG" until your Board have had a reply from China to the enquiries which you are making in the matter.
