Nature of Survey S.S. No. 1 When due 10-06

The S.S.No.1 became due in October 1906.

The New York Surveyors now state they are informed by the Managing Owner that it is the desire of the company to withdraw the vessel's classification, the reason being that the cargo carried is insured in local offices which favor classification with the two American Societies, and although they prefer Lloyd's classification they cannot see their way to retain three classifications.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
