I beg to acquaint you that the Generals of this Society have given their careful consideration to the remarks in your letter of the 27th October regarding the classification in the Society's Register of the vessels of your fleet.

The Committee regret to note the decision which has been arrived at by your goodships that the vessels which are engaged in the Mediterranean Trade should retain their classification to Lloyd's Register. In accordance with your wishes they have given instructions for the classes of the following vessels to be inserted in the Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu of the words "S.S." in the following list: "ABBZIA", "AVENTINO", "BRIONI", "CARNIOLIA", "CELIO", "CLEOPATRA", "GALICIA", "GASTEIN", "GIANICOLO", "HELOUAN", "LEOPOLIS", "MERANO", "NET", "PALATINO", "PRAGA", "QUIRINALE", "SEMIRAMIS", "TRENTO" and "VIENNA".
