### PARTS NOW EXAMINED.

No.2 Starboard Main Engine, Piston, Cylinder liner, Crosshead, Top and bottom end bearings, 4 new piston rings fitted.  
No.5 Starboard Main Engine, Piston, cylinder liner, crosshead, top and bottom end bearings, new piston rings fitted.  
No.3 Port Main Engine, piston, cylinder liner, crosshead, top and bottom end bearings, new piston rings fitted.  
No.5 Port Main Engine, piston, cylinder liner, crosshead, top and bottom end bearings, new piston rings fitted.  
No.3 Generator, H.P. Compressor piston rings renewed. I.P. Compressor 4 piston rings renewed. L.P. Compressor, 2 piston rings renewed. New rings fitted to both Engine pistons, ( 2nd cylinder).  
New gudgeon pins fitted to after piston. After bottom end bearings re-metalled.  
New keyways fitted on Camshafts of both Main Engines.  
No. 1 Auxiliary complete. No.3 Auxiliary complete with air bottles and Dynamo.  
Port and Starboard starting air receivers seen internally and externally with fittings.  
Spare injection air receivers (2) with fittings.

7/42. Satisfactory tests of both Main Engines on this date.

All repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction and I have RECOMMENDED that the vessel continue as at present classed and that the record of C.S. L M C, 7, 42 (in red) be made in the Register Book when the survey has been completed.
