With reference to the record in the Supplement to Lloyd's Register Book (Letter J. No. 4) concerning the Icebreaker "J.D. HAZEN", I beg to say that later reports on this vessel received from the Society's Surveyors in America give the name as "NIKOLA SELIANINOVITCH", the Ownership as The Imperial Russian Government, and the Port of Registry as Petrograd.

On the other hand, I find from the Registrar General of Shipping & Seamen that the vessel has a British Register under the name of J.D. Hazen, the registered Owners being Canadian Vickers Ltd., and the Port of Registry Montreal.

I should feel much favoured if you will be so good as to let me know what records should be made in the Register Book in this instance.
