The S.S.No.1 became due in June 1908, and the year of
grace expired at the end of June last.

The vessel was originally owned by the London County
Council, and as she was laid up, the Council gave the usual
undertaking.

The vessel was recently purchased by Messrs.G.A.Stewart
& Co., of this City, who stated on the 10th instant that she
was proceeding to St.Petersburg, and that no survey or
classification was necessary for the work which she would have
to do.

The case received the consideration of the Classing
Committee on the 10th instant, and it was decided to give
instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the
Register Book, and to insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof,
indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
