

TRANSEAFATION.

The Society Cargos Algeriens, of which the head office is at Dunkirk, 18 rue de Marechal French, has just acquired the steamer "MUNDALE" of 5,400 tons dead weight, built at Port Glasgow, for the purpose of being affected to the regular service between Algeria - Rouen - Dunkirk.

The "MUNDALE" is to be called the "MITIDJA" after the fertile plain behind the port of Algiers, of which the natural products constitute a very important part of the traffic destined for the Northern ports. This is the 4th vessel that this new Society has put into this service and now possess 22,000 tons D.W. in full working order.

The "MITIDJA" is shortly expected at Dunkirk carrying a cargo of 5,000 tons of coal from Newcastle, where she has received a temporary French certificate, and will carry out in out port all the work for her classification with Bureau Veritas, as also the works required for fitting her for the special service for which she is intended.

The purchase of this vessel increases by an interesting unit the fleet of the port of Dunkirk, where she will be registered. We wish a long and happy career
