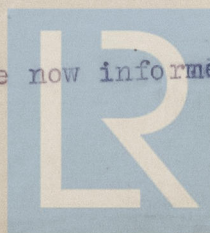

was arranged that in this event an additional premium was to be  
paid by the Assured, of which provision they notified the Owners  
of the vessel, who agreed to pay the amount of such increased  
premium.

The Owners Agents have now informed us that the vessel's
