We beg to refer to our conversation of this morning and to our request that you would kindly place again before the Committee that Special Survey No. 3 for this steamer might be postponed until steamer's arrival in Antwerp. One of the principal reasons of the Owner's request, being ~~that~~ the high cost of any kind of repairs effected in the States. As we stated, cargo which the steamer will be carrying outwards from the States is of a non-perishable nature namely coals to Malmo, and thence direct from the Baltic to Antwerp with a cargo of wood.

We shall be very much obliged if you will kindly place the matter again before the Committee for reconsideration, and we await your kind reply.
