Survey SS No 3 due 5.17 Advanced General Examination

The 1st. s.s. No. 3, due 5.17, has been partly held by the lifting of the ceiling in the fore and after holds, and testing of Nos. 1,2,4 and 5 double bottom tanks. Repairs are required in way of bunkers and to deck plating in way of Officers' accomodation.

The case, which is fully stated in endorsement dated 23.2.20, received consideration on the 24th.ultimo, when the Committee agreed to the vessel proceeding from Rouen to New York without completing the special survey, provided the survey and all repairs are definitely completed at the latter port, if not done at Rouen.

The Havre Surveyors now report the s.s. No. 3 further advanced by the examination of Nos. 2,3 and 4 holds, the tween deck cross bunker and the fore rigging.

A general examination has been made as far as practicable and the Surveyors recommend the record of "Examined 2.20" and state that it is understood that measures will be taken to complete the special survey at New York on the vessel's arrival. Nothing further could be done this time at Rouen owing to the labour dispute.

The Owners now ask if, as so much has been effected towards the special survey, the Committee would kindly allow the vessel to return from New York to Rouen ^{or} ~~and~~ Antwerp where the necessary will then be done to complete the s.s.No.3.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.




