I beg to acknowledge receipt of Your letter of the 27th July, 1921, regarding the Steamer "Spirit of Tres".

This steamer is still in Montevideo, and in several interviews with the Director, Sub-Director and the Inspector for the Navy, I have been informed that arrangements were being made to hold the Survey for re-instatement in her Class.
