I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the steam trawler "ROSEDALE" and in reply I have the pleasure to say that in the circumstances you mention the Committee are agreeable to the Second Special Survey No.1 of this vessel being postponed until next summer. The Committee are also agreeable to the survey of the screw shaft of the steam trawler "OKINO" and the Special Survey No.1 of the survey of the screw shaft of the "HONDO" being similarly postponed.

As you are aware, the Committee have deferred action in the cases of your trawlers "JAPAN", "PEKEN", "TOKIO 11" and "YESSO" as these vessels are being employed by the Government.
