Dear Sir,

I am requested to enclose herewith Piraeus Report No.5876 of a survey held by you on the old tanker "ANNE DE FRANCE" in July 1951.

At the same time I enclose Marseilles Report No.11363 on this ship, and would call your special attention to the Surveyor's remarks at the foot of the page over leaf which has reference to the recent Circular 1994 on old tankers.

The Surveyor has recommended that the ship's qualifications for the carriage of petroleum in bulk should be investigated by the end of February next, and I shall be glad to have your comments thereon.

It would appear that as there is midship accommodation situated on the top of the cargo tanks it should be separated from the cargo below by a cofferdam, and there would also appear to be need for a second check up on the electrical installation and pumping arrangements.

Please return the enclosed reports with your reply.
