With reference to your letter of 23rd May regarding the above ship, it is considered here that the carriage of oil fuel in the cofferdam is undesirable but it has been accepted in previous cases and, in the present instance, where the Owner seems to specially desire such an arrangement, it may be accepted.

As mentioned in an earlier letter, this is conditional upon no connection being in existence between the ship's oil fuel system and the cargo tank lines or between the cofferdam and the cargo tank lines.

It is hoped that this information suits your purpose.
