Nature of Survey

The Newcastle Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated and on account of damage through grounding 17 shell plates have been faired and minor repairs effected.

Nos. 1 and 4 double bottom tanks have been cemented and Nos. 2, 5 and 6 have been cemented over rivets.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 12.32.
