We beg to state that in addition to the fees shown on this Report and the Renewal Freeboard Survey fee of £4, it is proposed at this time to charge a fee of £10 for our survey of the extension of four main watertight bulkheads into the shelter 'tween decks. It is thought well, however, to submit this suggested fee for your consideration in view of the fact that similar cases will have been dealt with at other ports, and you will no doubt desire uniformity of practice. 



Rpt. Form 10
