This work is to be completed at Havre, and the report for that part done at this Port is forwarded.

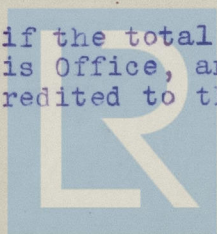
