Equipment No. 6413.

This vessel was built in Germany in 1906 and was not classed in the Society's Register Book.

The new Owners, the Instone Transport Trading Co., now desire the vessel to be classed 100A1 with this Society.

The particulars of the Bower Anchors and Chain Cable as required by the Rules and on board the vessel are as follows:-

It will be noted that, although two Bower Anchors only are supplied, their collective weight is 3qrs. 21 lbs greater than that of the three bower anchors required by the Rules, and that the Chain Cable is 15 fathoms longer and $\frac{1}{8}$ " greater in diameter than required by the Rules.

There is no kedge anchor on board, but proposals to dispense with this have already been approved by the Committee.

The remainder of the equipment is in excess of the Rule requirements.

In the circumstances the equipment is submitted for the favourable consideration of the Committee for the Figure 1.
