Report of Grain Condition Survey

S. S. "DONALD STEWART"

This is to Certify that

John Stephen

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Canada Steamship Lines, Ltd., Owners, attend on board the S. S. "DONALD STEWART", 1781 tons gross of Montreal, for the purpose of examining the vessel in accordance with the requirements of the Grain Underwriters, in order to ascertain whether the vessel is in fit condition to load and transport Grain Cargoes.

The undersigned examined the vessel internally and externally while afloat at Kingston, Ontario, on April 2nd, 1942, witnessed the hose testing of the deck in way of the cargo holds, examined the hatches and other deck openings to the holds, hatch covers, tarpaulins, etc. The limber boards were lifted in order to ascertain the condition underneath, and all limber boards were renewed. The bilges were cleaned out, and bilge suction strums cleared. The air and sounding pipes, steam and exhaust piping in the cargo holds were examined. All the foregoing found or made in good condition.

All electric wiring in the cargo spaces is run in metal conduit. The fixtures under deck at scuttle hatches are protected with vapor proof globes.

The equipment, comprising anchors, chains, and hawsers, was found complete in accordance with this Society's Requirements.

The boilers were examined internally and the machinery externally, and so far as could be seen, are in good order.

This vessel, in my opinion, is in fit condition to load and transport Grain Cargoes.
