This ship has sustained extensive damage caused by mine explosion on 18.7.53 when on a voyage in loaded condition.

The KIEL Surveyors report (9,53) ship examined afloat and in drydock and necessary recommendations made, should it be decided to retain the ship in service.

The Owners state in a letter dated 17.10.53 that the ship is to be disposed of as scrap.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY SUBMITTED ACTION be DEFERRED pending further information regarding ultimate disposal of this ship.
