When due

This vessel is stated to have been built under the Special Survey of the Germanischer Lloyd to class *100 $\frac{A}{4}$ (E) & was launched before the plans were submitted for consideration, with a view to class with this Society.

The vessel has been examined in dry dock, the scantlings verified & found in accordance with the approved plans, and the workmanship & materials good.

The equipment of anchors & chains &c supplied, are equivalent to the requirements of the Rules, but the anchors & chains are stated to have been tested at Mannheim & Duisburg (presumably by the Germanischer Lloyd's Surveyor).

It is submitted for consideration whether in the circumstances the figure "1" should be assigned without the record of A & C.P.

If the Committee approve, the vessel in other respects appears worthy to be classed 90.A1, steel, as recommended.

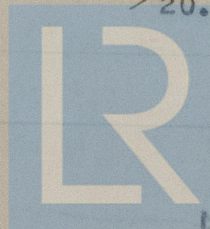
