The oil retaining gland is of the "Cedarval" type.

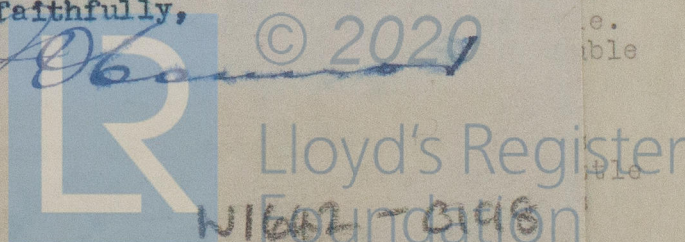
I have been able to procure photostats of plans of the Midship Section and General Arrangement of this vessel which are enclosed for your information.
