Dear Mr. Bennett,

We have now received Jacksonville reports No. 936 on the yacht "MOANA" ex "STRANGER" and this is certainly a big step forward in clearing up this long outstanding matter.

From the accounting side, however, there is one point on which I should like a little more information. It appears from the reports now to hand that the charges for the services detailed therein amounted in all to \$1000. Mr. Boyle's account for the September Quarter 1938 dealt with these fees, but he also brought into his account for the March Quarter 1938 another \$900 for this yacht and into his account for June Quarter 1938 \$150 more. I notice that the earliest date of survey on the reports is given as 5th June 1938.

Will you please let me know what services were rendered by Mr. Boyle for these additional charges amounting to \$1050 and whether any reports were or are to be made out by the Surveyor on this part of the work.

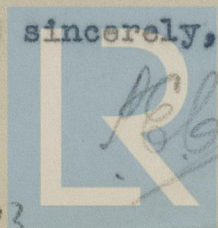
