the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Cooper Bessemer Corporation, Grove City, Pa., attend at their works on May 18th, 1937 and subsequent dates thereafter, for the purpose of inspecting, to this Society's Special Survey, Two (2) Diesel Engines; Manufacturer's Numbers 1201 and 1258; four cycle; single acting; three cylinders; 8" bore; 10-1/2" stroke; each developing 78 B.H.P. at 450 R.P.M.; built to the order of Mr. William B. Leeds, Oyster Bay, Long Island, New York, and intended for Yacht "MOANA".

Each engine, direct connected to a 50 K.W. direct-current generator and mounted on a sub-base, was tested under full and intermediate electrical loads in the shop. The materials and workmanship were found to be sound and efficient and the bench tests satisfactory. (No examination was made of the generators during construction.)
