

# POSTPONED SURVEYS.

"Laid up pending survey" assigned 19.9.52.

As a result of a General Examination carried out at Curacao, 1951, the Committee agreed to the Special Survey being postponed until December last. Later the Committee agreed to the extension in question being postponed until March/April last. In June a further letter was received from the Owners, stating that the Special Survey might be postponed for 3 more months until the end of August. This was agreed to provided, that the survey for the extension of the Loadline Certificate, which was carried out on the 31st May, was carried out, the Surveyors were satisfied that the vessel was in a fit condition for this further postponement. The Loadline Renewal Survey was carried out but no report on condition of the vessel was received, accordingly, enquiry was made of the Curacao Surveyors who stated the vessel had been laid up since the 31st August and was to be sold. The vessel has recently been sold and the attached correspondence has been received from the new Owners requesting that the vessel's Loadline Certificate might be extended to allow the vessel to proceed to Europe.

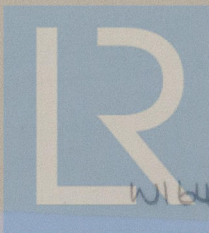
