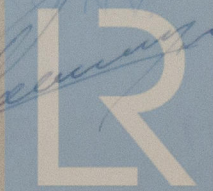
As you will realise it is extremely difficult for us to be able to carry out the necessary repairs at Curacao due to poor facilities, and your help in this connection would be much appreciated.
