We have purchased the above vessel from the
Carribbean Petroleum Company of New York, and we hope to
be able to take the delivery in the immediate future. The
vessel is presently lying in Curacao, and is due for special
repairs.

It is our intention to install Diesel Engines in
the vessel, which we have at present available in Rotterdam
to pass a special survey on the vessel. We wish, however,
to be able to get the vessel to Europe and in this connection
we shall be obliged if you could look into the position and
advise whether you can grant an extension of class for one voyage
from Curacao to Rotterdam with cargo to enable us to undertake
the necessary repairs on her arrival in Rotterdam.

As you will realise it is extremely difficult for
us to be able to carry out the necessary repairs at Curacao
on account of the poor facilities, and your help in this connection
would be much appreciated.

We have asked our friends Messrs. S.L.A. Ltd., of
St. Mary Axe, to kindly send this letter on to you and we
shall be obliged if you will contact them and advise them of
our decision, and we are sure they will be able to supply you
with any further information that you may require.
