SHIP'S NAME "FAUNUS" REPORT Suz. No. 93

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The previous history of this tanker is fully stated on memo dated 28.12.51 and Endorsement dated 20.5.52.

The Notation of "Laid Up - Surveys Overdue" was inserted in the Register Book 14.4.53.

In a letter dated 17.12.53 the Owners advise that they propose to tow ship over to the U.K. where she will be offered for sale for breaking up purposes and request the issue of a certificate to cover the proposed voyage.

The SUEZ Surveyor, who was authorised, reports (1,54), this tanker examined in dry dock and generally examined with a view to her being towed to U.K. for breaking up purposes.

Minor repairs were effected.

IT IS SUBMITTED no further ACTION need be taken pending receipt of further information as to the ship's ultimate disposal.
