The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

First Entry

It is submitted the Amsterdam Surveyors be informed that this vessel has proceeded to their port for the fitting of boiler Machinery, and that to complete the survey the engine seating requires to be fitted; machinery to be placed on board; engine room casing and skylight to be completed; pillars in machinery space to be arranged for and fitted.

They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work forward a report on Form 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.

At the same time the approved profile and deck plan should be returned to the Dundee Surveyors, and they should be requested to state how many of the oil tight bulkheads extend to the upper deck outside the expansion trunk, and the plan should be altered to agree with the report.
