It is submitted that Mr. ^{Chairman} ~~Leeuwenburg~~, the Society's Senior Ship Surveyor at Rotterdam, be requested to join the Amsterdam Surveyors and to report jointly ^{upon} upon the construction of the seating and the workmanship to which the Owners take exception. They should also forward a sketch showing fully the construction of the engine seating as fitted in the vessel.
