SUBMITTED record of docking 5,53 be assigned, subject to set in and indented shell plates (p & s), bridge deck plating, A.P. and F.P. tank top being specially examined and permanently repaired by next Special Survey (A.P. tank not to be used for carriage of feed water until repaired), main mast being kept under observation at periodical surveys, and to bottom of sternframe (EW.8,52) being specially examined next drydocking, with Endorsement (B).
