Parts now examined:—


Port Main Engine Nos. 4 & 6 cylinder liners, pistons, piston rods, covers, valves and valve gear, crossheads and their bearings; the crankshaft and its bearings of the aft (No.3) auxiliary engine. Donkey boiler internally and externally including mountings, manholes, doors and fastenings. Subsequently under steam and the safety valves adjusted. Oil fuel burning installation and steam smothering under working conditions.
