Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 26th instant, respecting the 'tween deck water ballast spaces abreast the engine casing in the Steel Twin Motor Vessel "DORSETSHIRE", I beg to state that these tanks have been fitted as shown on the approved plan. The water ballast spaces in the upper 'tween decks are 47' long, and each tank has a capacity of 130 tons, and the fresh water tanks in the lower tween decks are 26' long, and each tank has a capacity of 35 tons. These latter tanks however, cannot be used for anything but fresh water.
