Details of Casualty

This yacht was burnt out at her moorings in Emsworth harbour on the 4th May. She subsequently sank about one mile from the quay.

The owner concurs she is a total loss.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION

GIROFLEE (yacht).—London, May 5.—The ketch Giroflee was burnt out at her moorings in Emsworth harbour, Hampshire, just before dawn yesterday. With her contents the vessel was estimated to be worth £50,000.—"Daily Mail."

London, May 5.—Michael Sweeney, a yacht hand, fought a fire in the ketch Giroflee yesterday. The yacht, owned by Mr. H. Alan Mackay, of Lincoln's Inn Fields, was practically burnt out by the time she was beached.—"Daily Herald."

GIROFLEE (yacht).—Portsmouth, May 6.—Ketch Giroflee: Have contacted master, who states that ketch caught fire at moorings in Emsworth harbour at about 2 a.m. on Sunday, May 4. Watchman on board but not injured. Ketch since put on mud and now sunk about one mile from Emsworth quay.—Lloyd's Agents. (See issue of May 6.)
