

Dear Sirs,

S. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your telegram of yesterday's date requesting that the classification certificates for the hull and machinery of the motor tanker "GULFBIRD" may be forwarded to you to be handed to the builders by Monday, and in confirmation of my telephone message to you this morning, I have to say that the plans which are mentioned on your first entry report as having been forwarded have not come to hand, and I would point out that there is a pencilled note on the report referring to the plan in question which reads "Not yet to hand will be forwarded later".

In view of this, these plans are awaited before dealing with the report, ^{but} as the case appears to be urgent, the report ~~has been~~ checked with the Office copies here of the plans, and a half-certificate for the hull has been prepared, which, together with the machinery certificate, is now enclosed herewith.
