Your request for information on Owners' intention in regard to the outstanding surveys on the abovementioned vessel was referred to Mr. S.T. Williamson who replies as follows:-

"INCHMAY"

This vessel is expected here next week and we regret that we are not in a position, owing to uncertain conditions, to determine exactly what will be done regarding Survey and she will remain here pending a decision.

"INCHKEITH"

Owing to lack of employment we are still undecided as to what will be done regarding this vessel's Survey, however, we will advise you when we have anything definite.

It would appear that these two vessels will join the several other "Williamson craft" laid up at this Port. The type of vessel, coupled with local conditions, would seem to preclude repair at this time.
