



Docking Survey.

Now done:

The vessel was placed in the Government Graving Dock.

The propeller and sea connections and fastenings were examined and found in good condition.

The steering engine and windlass were examined without opening out, seen under working conditions and found in order.

Boiler Survey.

Now done:

The port, centre and starboard boilers were examined internally and externally with mountings and the safety valves adjusted under steam.

Repairs now effected:

Centre Boiler.

5 leaking plain tubes stoppered.

General Examination of this vessel to proceed to Japan in loaded condition

The main engines and Auxiliaries were now generally examined externally and found in good running condition.

The steering engine was seen under working conditions and together with the auxiliary steering gear found in good order.

The windlass was examined under working conditions and found in order.

The electrical installation was examined externally, seen under working conditions and found efficient.

The machinery and boilers were seen under working conditions and found in order.

The Machinery of this vessel as now seen is in good and efficient condition and capable in all respects to maintain its position in the Register Book with fresh record of 28.7.22 and Docking Survey 7.22
