Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a report from the Society's Surveyors at this Port on the machinery of the steamer "EMPIRE BITTERN", from which it appears that, in view of the condition of the Screwshaft liners, it is recommended that the starboard liner should be renewed before the end of June 1945, and the port liner before the end of June 1946, and the Committee have accordingly continued the vessel's classification in the Register Book subject to this being done.

I may add that the Boiler Survey has been completed, and the vessel assigned the record B.S.3,44.
