Dear Mr. Bryden,

s.s. "ALSTER" now "EMPIRE ENDURANCE".

We are considering the plans of the above vessel which was formerly classed 100 $\frac{1}{4}$  With Freeboard by the Germanischer Lloyd. The moulded draft of the vessel is stated by the Surveyors to be 28' 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " summer. Could you inform us as soon as convenient to you if this corresponds approximately to the minimum freeboard which could be assigned to the vessel. It appears to us that this is so, considering her as having a depth of 33' 8" to the upper deck and a poop and combined bridge and forecastle.

I enclose the plans of profile & decks and Midship Section.
