Referring to your letter of the 12th instant, regarding the above vessel, this vessel is now at this Port undergoing survey for classification and freeboard assignment.

We submit herewith for the consideration of the Committee, plans in duplicate, of the midship section, profile & decks, sternframe, Oertz rudder, castings for rudder, rudder coupling and detail of rudder pintle.

Plans of bilge and ballast pumping arrangement, air and sounding and scuppers and discharges will be forwarded within a day or two.

There are no certificates on board this ship but it is hoped to have these forwarded from the Admiralty and from the information available it appears that the moulded draught of this vessel was 28'-1½" summer.


