Summer Load Line	S	level with top of line through centre of disc.			
Winter Load Line	W	6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "	below	S	

The Upper edge of the deck line from which these freeboards are measured is 10 inches above the top of the stringer plate on the freeboard deck at side.

This Certificate remains in force until Official Certificate is issued.
