Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 11th instant confirming your previous conversation with Mr. Hodgson, from which it is noted that the Court of Enquiry into the loss of the Steamer "NEDJAN" desires that a Representative of the Society should be present to answer any questions which may be put. It is noted that you would be prepared to attend personally, and this is quite satisfactory to the Committee.

For your information, I enclose the original reports of surveys held on this ship from the last Special Survey to the date of casualty, together with copies of the freeboard reports during this period.
