Dear Sir,

We duly received your letter of the 15th ultimo regarding the case of the steamer "NEDJAN". As suggested, we contacted the Owners of the vessel and, with their approval, a letter was sent to the Editor of "AFTONPOSTEN" informing him that the statement in the issue of that paper of the 11th January regarding the above ship was quite incorrect. As a result of this the following article appeared in the issue of "Aftonposten" for yesterday:-

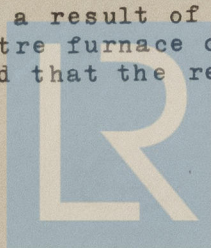
## TRANSLATION:-

### "NEDJAN SEAWORTHY. - REPAIR POSTPONED".

"Lloyd's Register of Shipping rejects the statement of a seaman that the Swedish ship "Nedjan", which was lost at the beginning of January, was condemned by Lloyd's at Aberdeen in November last year, but that the ship for some reason was given three months respite. This statement lacks all foundation state Lloyds.

The statement of the seaman was included in the "Aftonposten" of the 11th January. Lloyd's state that repairs were carried out at Aberdeen in November to the furnaces of the main boiler. The work was carried out to the satisfaction of Lloyd's Surveyor but it was recommended that the furnaces should be renewed on the ship's arrival at a Swedish port. The boiler pressure was reduced meanwhile.

Since new furnaces could not immediately be obtained further inspection was carried out at Trelleborg on the 27th November by Lloyd's Surveyor and, as a result of this, it was decided that the renewal of the centre furnace could be postponed until the end of February 1954 and that the reduced boiler pressure should still be retained.
