

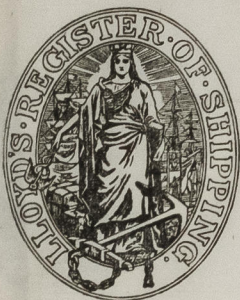

dealt with at the next S.S.

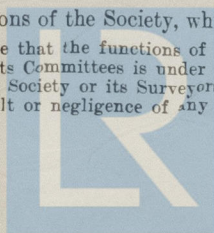
