Dear Sirs,

In reply to the enquiry contained in your letter of the 27th instant relative to the date of build of the "SNOW QUEEN", as recorded in the Society's Register Book, I have to inform you that since 1925, the date of build in the cases of vessels classed with this Society, is that of the completion of the vessel.

It may explain that prior to 1925, the Society's Rules provided that the date of build in the case of a steamer of this size, should be recorded as six months after the date of launching, if the vessel was not completed within that period.

In the case of this vessel however, the vessel was launched on the 28th October 1920, and was completed in April 1921, and therefore the date of build was recorded as April, 1921.
