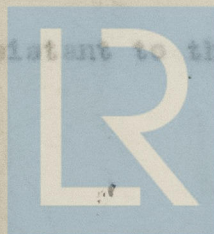
The plan forwarded is being retained for the guidance of the Surveyor during construction.
