Port 3, 4 & 6 and S. 5 & 6 crankpins and bearings.  
Both main thrusts, the aft L.O. pump, ballast pump, and the  
after manoeuvring air compressor with coolers, also the outboard  
piston cooling pump.  
The two lower ford. & aft air receivers internally and externally  
with fittings.
