This vessel was last submitted to the requirements of a Special Survey in 1936.

The 1st S.S. No. 3 became due ["]11.39, but as a result of a satisfactory General Examination at Middlesbrough in October 1939 a year of grace was granted for carrying out the Special Survey.

A further General Examination was held at Hong Kong mid 1941, and as a result of this the Special Survey was deferred for a further 12 months.

In September 1942 a General Examination was carried out, and in view of this a notation of "Examined 9.42" with validity of 12 months was assigned by the Committee, thus postponing the Special Survey until September 1943.

It is to be noted that whilst the vessel was at Alexandria in June 1943 to November 1943, the requirements of a Special Survey No. 3 were complied with, with the exception of the examination of the chain cables and chain locker.

The vessel was also examined and recommendation made for permanent repairs on account of damage by fire in No. 2 hold and cross bunker and subsequent grounding.

Pending the completion of the Special Survey a notation of "Examined 11.43" valid for 12 months was assigned.
