I duly received your letters of the 3rd and 7th instant, with enclosures advised therein, relating to shafting proposed for the above vessel, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that, with 2 SCSA oil engines for main propelling purposes, having 6 cylinders, diameter of cylinders 350 mm., stroke 620 mm., revolutions per minute 240, maximum pressure in cylinders 49 Kgs. per square cm., M.I.P. 5.35 Kgs. per square cm., B.H.P. 1000, diameter of propeller 2640 mm. and screw shaft with continuous liner, the proposed size of screw shaft, viz:- 192 mm. dia., will be approved.

The plan showing details of shaft will also be approved, and two copies are returned herewith.

It is noted that the diameter of this shaft will be 192 mm. and not 190 mm. as shown on the plan.
