E. I return herewith two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 21st instant, of arrangement of cofferdam sounding pipe proposed for Messrs. Soc. An. John Cockerill, Yard No. 657, and I have to inform you that this plan will be approved provided the arrangements be as shown thereon, and the remaining requirements of Section 20 of the Rules (1937-8) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is concluded that the cofferdam will be ventilated by means of air pipes, port and starboard, led from the tank top to the open, as per Section 20 D, Clause 3 (d).
